The Lord has blessed us with many supporting churches that faithfully pray and financially support us. Many of you sent love offerings and have helped us raise the fund for the van.

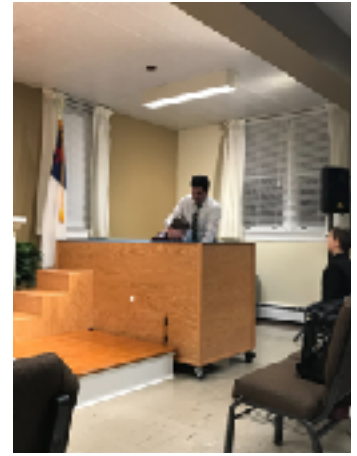


### **Sunday School Space**
